Congratulations! You've been selected as a judge for the 2006 **¡CARNAVAL SANTA FE!** Complete-Lack-Of-Talent Show and the 2006 King, Queen and Court Costume Contest.

Judge and Party Agenda:

- 7:00 pm – Enjoy the party, show off your scepter;
- 8:30 pm – Complete Lack Of Talent Show begins on stage
- 9:00 pm – Complete Lack Of Talent Show ends, Judges conclude all Talent voting;
Conga Line to view Costumes for Costume Contest Judging
- 10:00 pm - Award Ceremony begins, led by the Master of Ceremonies, in order:
 - Complete Lack Of Talent Show Runners Up then Winners
 - 2006 Carnival Court followed by King and Queen

1) 2006 ¡CARNAVAL SANTA FE! King, Queen and Court Costume Contest

The costume contest participants are *everybody* that attends the party.

Costume Contest judging is to be considered on an **individual** basis. This means that decisions for King and for Queen are to be held *irrespective* of whom the partner will be to any given costume. The award is for best *individual* costume, most representing the spirit of **¡CARNAVAL SANTA FE!**

2) 2005 ¡CARNAVAL SANTA FE! Complete-Lack-Of-Talent Show

Entering groups must all be in costume and get 3 minutes to:

Sing or dance, just having a good time...

Do a skit, think along the lines of Keystone Cops or The Three Stooges...

Tell/Act out a joke or two, be funny, crazy or hilarious...

Or just stand there in their costumes and “be ‘foolishly’ presented”

Consider the following Lack of Talent award category suggestions:

Most Outrageous...

Least Coordinated...

Worst use of costume material...

The Over-The-Top / Overkill award...

Judges Choice...

Funniest / Most Hilarious ...

Least Talented Player or Group...

We suggest awarding a maximum of 20 points to each team (or costume in costume contest) for fun, talent (or costume) & originality.
